The Board of Commissioners' meeting is for the second reading and public hearing of Ordinance No. 2021-7 approving a Major Text Amendment to modify Jackson County Land Development Ordinance (JCLDO) Section 6.5.3(B) to include Section 7.2 in review of temporary structures and uses in response to natural disasters and emergencies. Commissioner Dyer called the land use meeting to order on Wednesday, October 6, 2021, at 1:30 p.m. by videoconference.

Commissioner Dyer read the title of Ordinance No. 2021-7.

Mr. Benton read the admonishments. There were no conflicts of interest. Mr. Benton read Section 213.07, Rules for the Conduct of Public Hearings, of the Codified Ordinances of Jackson County.

Commissioner Dyer asked if there were any questions or comments for Planning staff, and there were none.

Commissioner Dyer opened the public hearing at 1:33 p.m. No one wished to speak. Commissioner Dyer closed the public hearing at 1:34 p.m.

The Commissioners moved to deliberations.

Commissioner Dotterer moved to adopt the proposed Major Text Amendment to Section 6.5.3(B) of the JCLDO to include Section 6.2 in review of temporary structures and uses in response to natural disasters and emergencies. File No. 439-21-00004-LRP.

Commissioner Roberts noted a correction in the motion as read. She clarified that the Major Text Amendment to Section 6.5.3(B) of the JCLDO is to include Section 7.2, not Section 6.2.

Commissioner Roberts seconded the motion as corrected. Those who voted aye: Commissioner Dotterrer, Commissioner Roberts, and Commissioner Dyer. Motion passed.

Following the motion and roll call vote, Commissioner Dotterrer, Commissioner Roberts, and Commissioner Dyer each authorized the use of his/her electronic signature on Ordinance No. 2021-7, pursuant to Order No. 1-21.
