The Jackson County District Attorney's Office announced today that Alfred Walker was sentenced on 1 count of Robbery in the Second Degree, 2 counts of Assault in the Fourth Degree, 1 count of Driving Under the Influence of Intoxicants, and 1 count of Assault in the First Degree. Walker will serve 100 months measure 11 in the Oregon Department of Corrections followed by 3 years of Post-Prison Supervision.

Walker's plea stems from two separate incidents. The first one was on January 5, 2019, at 6:30pm. The Medford Police Department responded to a robbery at the Rogue Valley Mall parking lot. The victim reported two males and a female approached him and told him "this is a robbery" they proceeded to remove him and his girlfriend from victim's Honda Civic and steal the car. That same day, at 7:43pm, the Jackson County Sheriff's Department received reports of a highspeed crash in Eagle Point. Walker was found to be the driver of the Honda Civic that had been stolen earlier that evening. Walker had failed to stop at a stop sign and crashed in to the side of a Ford F350. Both passengers in the Honda Civic were injured and transported to the hospital. Walker was found to be under the influence of intoxicants with a blood alcohol content of 0.15%

The second incident was on March 21, 2021. The Ashland Police Department responded to a report of an injured male at the Stop and Shop market located at 110 Lithia Way. Upon contacting the victim, he reported a male came up to him while sitting in an alley way and cut him on his neck with a knife. The victim reported he had been hanging out with the male earlier that evening, but had not known him prior to that day and did not know his name. The victim was transported to Ashland Community Hospital for a three-inch cut on his neck and medical professionals stitched the injury. Ashland Police Officers were able to follow a blood trail from 110 Lithia Way to an alleyway. Further investigation led to Alfred Walker being identified as the suspect, and the victim later positively identified him as the individual who stabbed him in a photo lineup.
