

**ROGUE VALLEY INTERNATIONAL-MEDFORD AIRPORT
AIRPORT COMMUNITY ENTHUSIAST (ACE) BOARD MEETING MINUTES
April 15, 2013**

I. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Chair, Tome' Olson, at 12:25 p.m. in Conference Room B at the Rogue Valley International-Medford Airport.
