Opening Remarks: Lee welcomed everyone to the February PSCC meeting.

Presentation – Safety from Sex Offenders: Nate Gairan from Community Justice provided a presentation regarding Sex Offenders and how Community Justice supervises this population within the Community. There were several questions from the council about supervision, who does what function (OSP versus JCCJ) and just how many sex offenders are in Jackson County. John Stromberg requested that this presentation be provided for the Ashland community. Since there is an abundance of myths and misinformation in the community surrounding the supervision of sex offenders, it would be beneficial to provide further presentations for public educational purposes. Lee noted that SOU could host such an event and media services could video the presentation for RVTV, if this is something that the PSCC supported. If done through SOU there would be no fee for taping.

Special Guest - Don Skundrick, County Commissioner: One of the new County Commissioners, Don Skundrick attended the PSCC meeting and was welcomed by the Council. Each member introduced themselves and a conversation developed regarding the PSCC and how each member fits into the council. A brief discussion about the proposed budget from the Governor's office was started and a powerpoint from the DAS was sent to the members after the meeting, along with the Drug Court Report completed by the NPC and the results were shared via email.

Announcements / Other Business: Brief discussion about the M11 report currently being conducted by the Criminal Justice Commission. The PSCC will receive a copy once it is approved by the CJC.
