Bob asked if anyone had any agency updates that they would like to provide:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Eric Guyer from the Community Justice Transition Center identified they will be utilizing one of the houses on the property (Access House) for Mental Health female clients who are in need of short-term housing. Currently there is no short-term Mental Health housing options for females and this shift in focus will provide an additional resource to the community.• Judge Joe Charter from the Justice Court expressed interest in assisting the Circuit Court, if needed, in providing access to their new facility and court room in case of overflow or emergencies etc. Bob identified the Justice Department actually has two portable tents that can be utilized in case of natural disaster or emergency to allow the courts to continue to function.
