NEW DISTRICT ATTORNEY BUILDING

| <p>Beth Heckert gave a tour of the new District Attorney (DA) building that is still in the construction phase. They are expecting to move in on September 1st; the move will be gradual as the office cannot close for the move as operations cannot be interrupted. The new building is approximately 20,000 square feet, which is double in size compared to the current area available to the agency, which is approximately 10,000 square feet. The new building will provide all divisions of the District Attorney's office to be in one building instead of multiple, as in the current set up. This will allow additional efficiency and will assist in operations. Some additional improvements within the new building consist of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• A larger Grand Jury room with a kitchenette, bathrooms, and the capability to utilize technology more efficiently for operations.• Conferences rooms for staff meetings; currently the DA's office does not have a conference room big enough to hold an all staff meeting or an attorney staff meeting.• New employee breakroom• Secure parking for staff and a larger public parking area (once the current DA building is demolished)• New victim rooms and meeting spaces.• There will be four secure and private stations for child support to talk to victims.• Public bike area that will be open during office hours but will be locked after a certain time to help prevent theft• Library/Media/Conference room• Discovery room <p>Beth offered to provide another tour of the building once finished.</p> | |
