**Residential Barriers 2 Bridges Program
Twelve Year Data Trend Reports**

SUMMARY

Information on Jackson County juvenile offenders was collected, entered and maintained in the Juvenile Justice Information System (JJIS). JJIS is a state-wide electronic case management system used by all counties in the state of Oregon and maintained by the Oregon Youth Authority.

Items to consider when reviewing data:

Small changes in raw numbers between years may create large percentages. For example, a change from 6 to 2 creates a change of 67%. Review both the raw numbers and percentages to determine the significant of these changes.

SUMMARY

Since 2011-2012 the department has been operating a 15 bed residential program for delinquent youth on probation with Jackson County. In 2018 this program was reduced down to 10 beds to help with staffing and right fit the treatment component to this environment. The program is for male youth between the ages of 10 and 20 years of age to help improve the lives of youth by providing behavioral intervention, counseling, and skills-training services. Medium to high risk are placed in the program for up to six months for services and to prevent further movement into the juvenile justice system.

Although only 44% of youth graduated, completed or reached maximum benefit this past year these youth and families were given an opportunity to remain locally and received services. Youth are held accountable for their actions and progression in the treatment process, if they are unwilling to engage then they are terminated. Of the youth terminated from the program, 60% (6) went to another residential program after being committed to the custody of the Oregon Youth Authority. 30% (3) of youth returned home.

Ages 15 to 17 continue to be the highest number and percentage of youth admitted to the detention facility. White youth (71%) followed by Hispanic youth (19%) are the largest admissions by race.

Graduated: Youth excelled in segments of program to include school, daily functioning, peer relations, family dynamics & group participation
Completed: Youth demonstrated satisfactory effort in most segments of his program to include school, daily functioning, peer relations, family dynamics, group participation.

Maximum Benefit: Youth that have completed a vast majority of the program but are unable to make any further progress. Continued placement could cause regression in treatment.

OYA Residential: Youth committed to the Oregon Youth Authority for out-of-home placement

OYA Youth Correctional Facility: Youth committed to the Oregon Youth Authority for placement in the Youth Correctional Facility

Other: Home or substance abuse in-patient treatment program
