Setting Up Your Account

New accounts require an application and photo identification. Applications can be downloaded from our website and brought to the Road's Administration office for processing.

Once an account number has been issued, account holders can add account funds online at Pay4Water.com or at our office.

Your account must be active and have a credit balance in order to obtain water at the water station. You pay only for the water that you get.

Credit cards accepted for payment are: Visa, Master Card, American Express, and Discover. Pay4Water.com is a secure payment portal. **\$20 minimum purchase.**

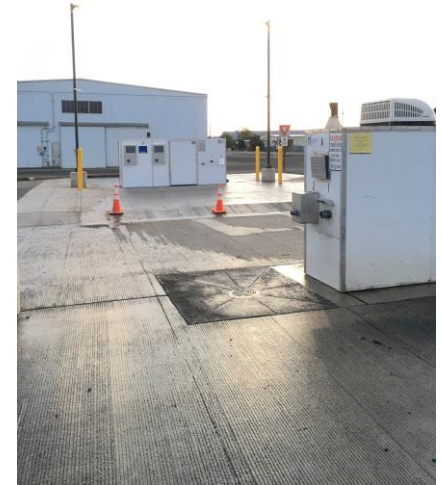

Using the Water Station

In order to connect to the water station, you will need to obtain your own hose and the necessary female 2" or 3" camlock connection as shown below:



The water station has the matching male connector. If using the 3" connector you are **REQUIRED** to have a hard connection to your tank. For safety purposes **DO NOT** attempt to hold the hose with your hands!

Connectors are standard. They can be purchased at plumbing/fitting and hose vendors in our area such as:

- Oregon California Supply (5186 Crater Lake Avenue, Central Point – just north of Vilas Road)
- Munnell & Sherrill (2080 Commerce Drive, Medford – near the Les Schwab store on Crater Lake Highway)
- Coastal (Leigh Way, White City) - 2" only
- Grover Electric & Plumbing (N. Pacific Hwy, Medford) – 2" only

Water Station Tips

- Traffic flow is one way. Stay in a single line until an opening occurs.
- Be ready with your hose and process to keep the line moving.
- Make use of both sides of the station. Ensure your hose is long enough to reach when used from either side.
- Use a semi-rigid hose.
- Keep overflows to a minimum.

Account Information

- Accounts will be assigned a minimum of one Member Number with a Personal Identification Number (PIN).
- Accounts can have multiple members. Each member will be issued a unique Member Number and PIN.
- Additional members can be added at any time.
- Email receipts are available at the member and/or account level.
