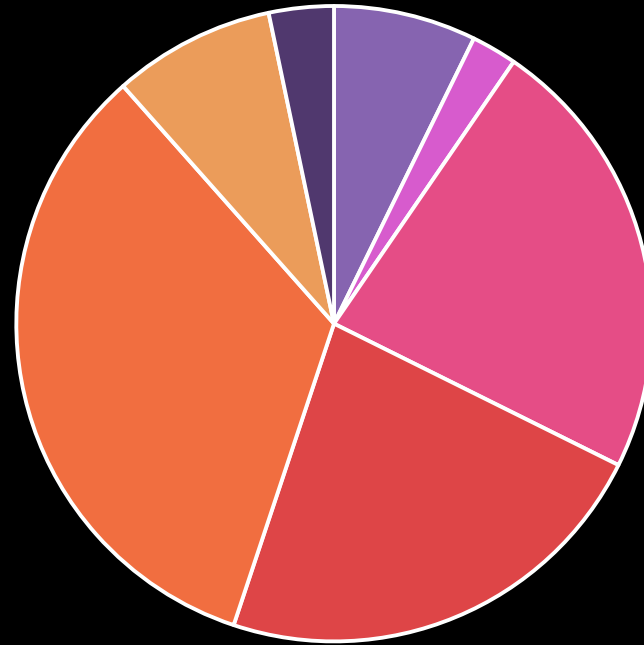
Overview of Prosecution

- 54 FTE with 23 Deputy District Attorneys
- 90% of the funding for Prosecution comes from General Fund
- Filed 7533 cases in 2018/2019 fiscal year

- Domestic Violence Deferred

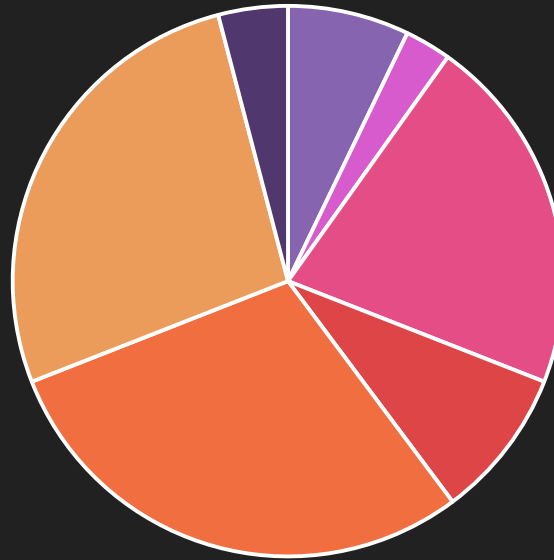
Snapshot of Jail Population on 7/12/19

Snapshot of Jail population on 8/5/19

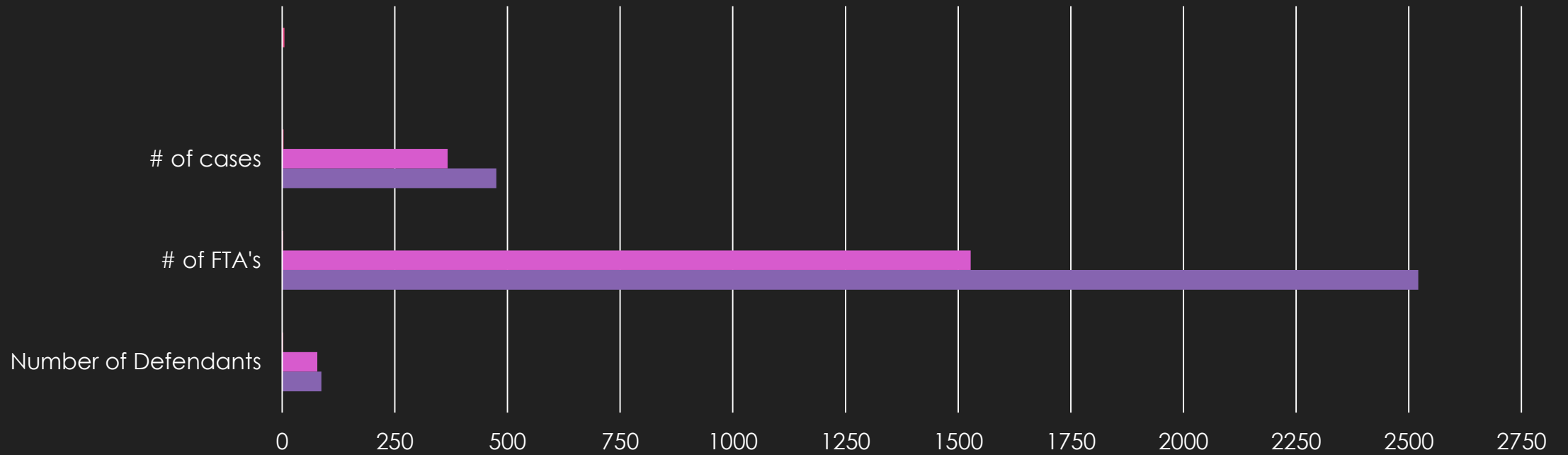

Standard Duii Plea Offers

- 1st offense: Diversion or 20 days jail
- 2nd offense: 30 - 45 days jail
- 3rd offense : Felony if within 10 years 75-120 days jail
- 4th offense: Felony if within 10 years 19-24 months prison
